The Journal of Clinical Psychiatry (JCP) publishes original peer-reviewed material by recognized authors in the psychiatric and behavioral/neural sciences, with special emphasis on subjects relevant to the practicing clinical psychiatrist. In addition to original research, JCP publishes review articles; special focus sections on women's issues, dementia, and child and adolescent psychiatry; case reports; clinical reports; book reviews; and letters to the editor. JCP also publishes highlights of academic symposia and timely clinician commentary augmenting original research and offers Continuing Medical Education.

JCP also publishes special Supplements during the year that generally contain proceedings from scientific symposia.

IF ▶ JCP is the 3rd most cited psychiatric journal in the world with an IF of 5.533 (December 2008, Journal Citation Reports).

JCP is indexed in MEDLINE, Excerpta Medica, Psychological Abstracts, Current Contents, Science Citation Index, Hospital Literature Index, Biological Abstracts, Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature, International Nursing, Industrial Medicine, Chemical Abstracts, and Adolescent Mental Health Abstracts.

The ASCP, founded in 1992, is a group of nearly 800 physicians who study, practice, and are advocates for psychopharmacology and clinical research, consisting of doctoral level investigators of clinical pharmacology or pharmacology.

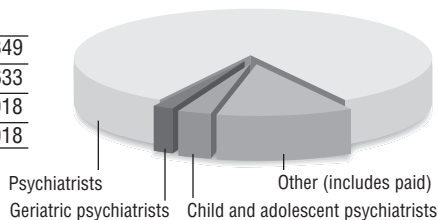
CIRCULATION

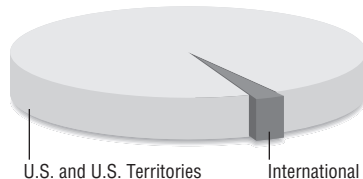
BREAKDOWN BY SPECIALTY
