Skin biopsy was taken from the site of lesion. The biopsy showed sparse superficial and deep perivascular and periappendageal infiltrate of lymphocytes and numerous eosinophils. Several eosinophils scattered in the interstitium of the reticular dermis and around the deep vascular plexus. The papillary dermis showed edema. The sections are displayed below.
